Role purpose:

To safely and effectively supervise the swimming pool and maintain the pool itself

Key result areas:

- To assist in maintaining the safety and welfare of all customers within the pool, in line with industry guidance (HSG 179 Managing health and safety in swimming pools).
- To ensure personal lifeguarding qualifications are current and attend monthly staff training
- To carry out water testing as required by the pool policy.
- To carry out routine maintenance and cleaning of the poolside and changing room, to ensure a hygienic and safe environment.
- To be aware of all emergency procedures and assist in avoiding and managing emergency situations.
- To ensure that all parts of the pool are made secure when not in use.
- To ensure that all chemicals are correctly used and stored
- To follow Peabody Health and Safety policies and procedures to ensure, as far as is practicable, your own safety and that of others in the workplace. You may be required to undertake specific Health and Safety roles such as Fire Warden or First Aider as part of your duties
